Rebuilt 1630**

St. Luke's Church, Charlton

St. Luke's Church is an Anglican parish church in the Diocese of Southwark with a remarkable history spanning 10 centuries. Records suggest that a church dedicated to St. Luke existed on the site around 1290. Remnants of chalk and flint walls have been found and may relate to the original building which operated under the authority of Bermondsey Abbey until the dissolution of the monasteries.

St. Luke's was rebuilt in 1630 and the present Grade 2 listed building is inextricably linked to Charlton House which is just across the road in the park.

Charlton House, one of the finest surviving Jacobean manor houses in the country, was built in 1612 for Sir Adam Newton, tutor to Henry, Prince of Wales, the eldest son of James I. Newton died in 1630 and left money in his will for the rebuilding of St. Luke's Church.

The church is an early example of the Italian Renaissance style of architecture, made famous on a much grander scale by Sir Christopher Wren; the simple semicircular arches inside are an example of this. The rich interior of St. Luke's contains many nationally important monuments and tombs which, arguably, are comparable to those contained in Westminster Abbey.

Friends of St. Luke's Church

The Right Honourable Spencer Perceval, the only British Prime Minister to be assassinated, has a plaque in Westminster Abbey, but he is buried in St. Luke's Church. The monument in the church has a bust by Sir Francis Chantrey, the leading portrait sculptor in Regency era Britain.

The upkeep of the building and maintaining it as a Grade 2 listed building remains a challenge for the church and our community.

The aim of the Friends is to raise money for the restoration and repair of the fabric of St. Luke's and to increase awareness of this remarkable building in our local community and beyond.
